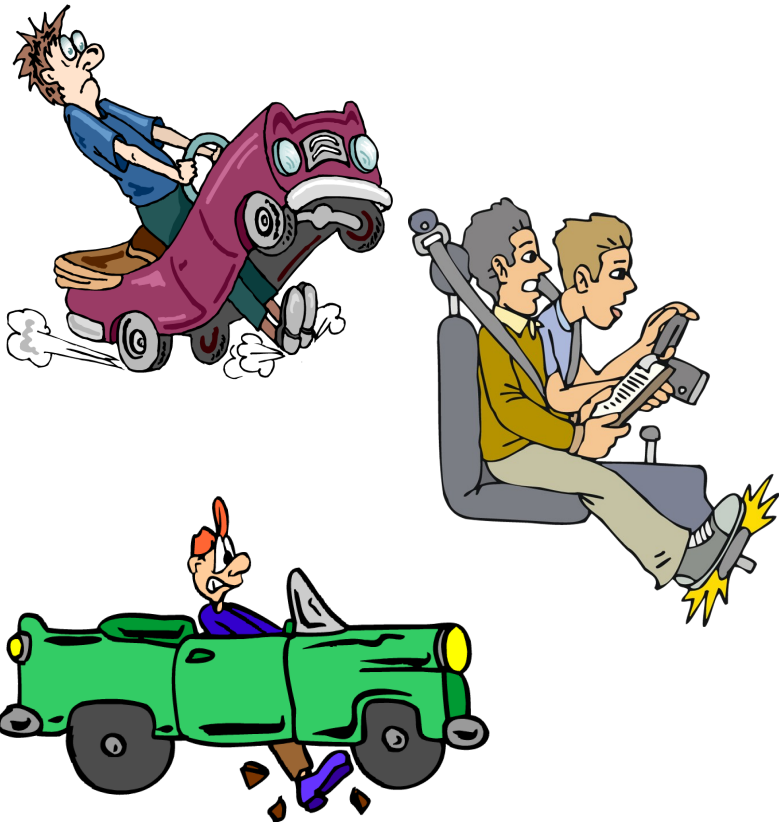


Are these illustrations showing beaks or brakes?

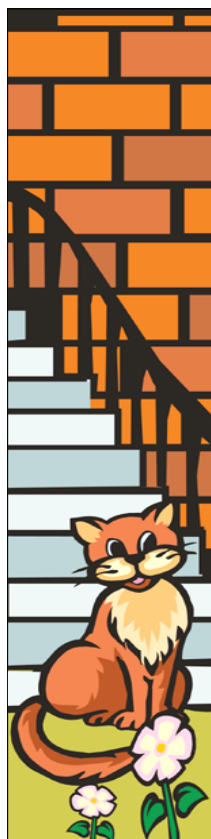
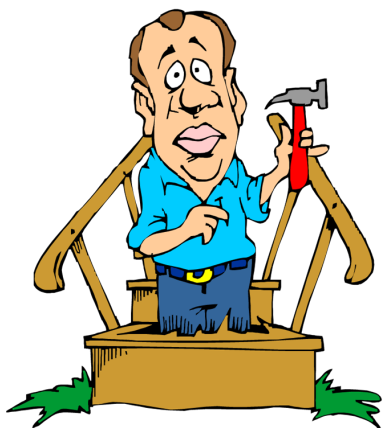


Are these dramatic illustrations showing brakes or beaks?

## Why this book is good

- The hyphen is demonstrated in this book to show its function to separate longer words over two lines
- Thinking up interesting and creative answers to questions becomes easier with practice
- It teaches you how to draft your thoughts and have them in the correct sequential order before speaking
- It encourages the use of the natural stressed and unstressed syllables in English. (Some languages do not have these stressed and unstressed syllables)
- New words not seen before can be worked out confidently by using a prior knowledge of phonics
- We use our brain voice for thinking and when reading silently, and an out-loud voice for speaking to people (or your pet or a soft toy ... ☺)
- The better your ability to talk to people of all ages and backgrounds in a friendly way, the more you will have a sense of well-being and self-confidence.
